Important information

- Class 2 will be taught by Mrs. Jordan, with teaching assistant support from Mrs Swallow on a morning and Mrs Scott in an afternoon.

In school, each week your child will be heard to read once within a group and once on a one to one basis with another adult.
- Spellings will be given weekly and will be sent home on a piece of paper that does not need to come back into school. Please can you encourage your child / children to practice their spellings ready for a weekly spelling test on a Monday.
- Children will require their P.E bags in school all week –PE sessions for Class 2 will take place every Monday and Thursday. Children need a pair of trainers, socks, warm trousers and a jumper, as where possible PE will be outside.
- Merits will be awarded to the children for going above and beyond their expectations and achieving the next step in their learning.
