



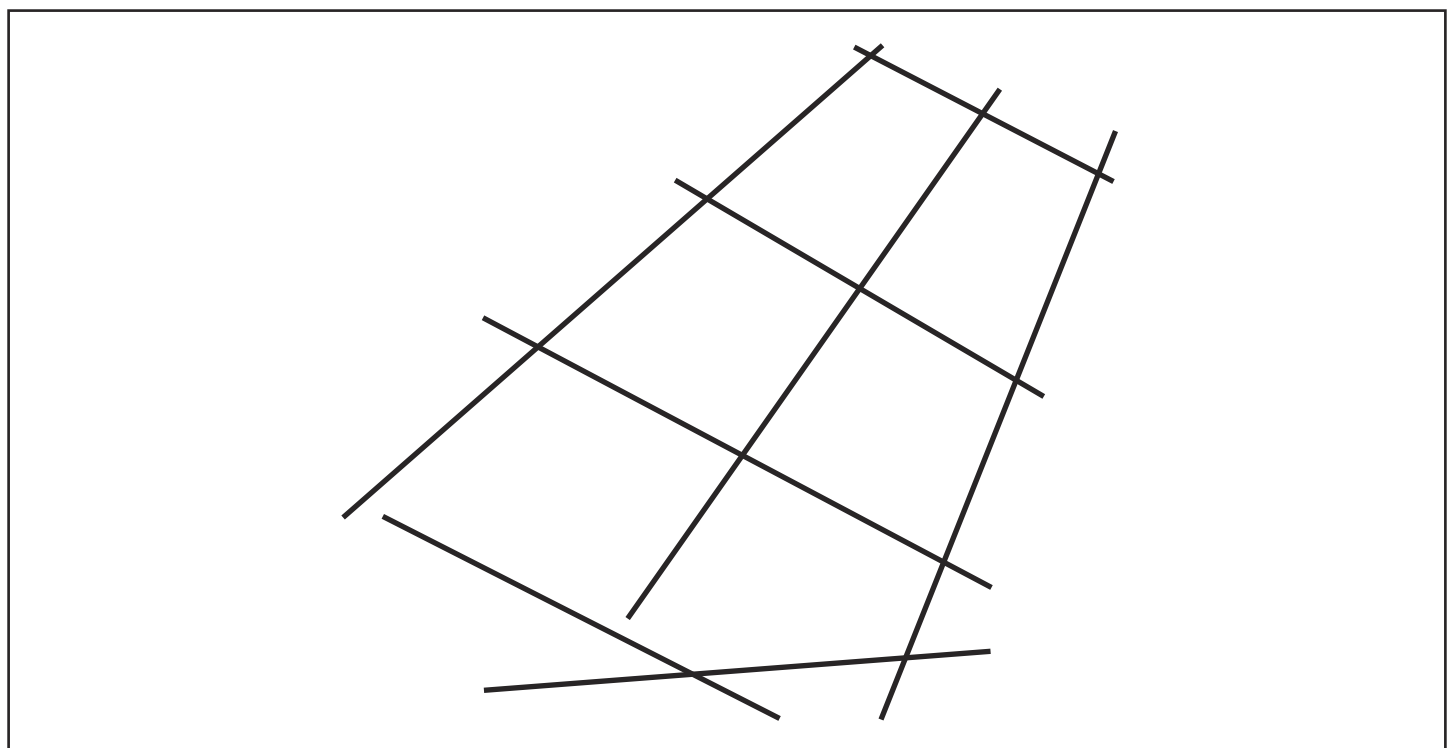


# Guidelines and Grids

## Guideline Drawing

Follow the step by step to draw from the image of the shoe. Remember to sketch lightly with your pencil and look at what you are drawing.

## Drawing from Observation

Your next task is to take off your own shoe and place it in front of you on the table. You will split the shoe up into block shapes when drawing.

You should draw in guidelines for:

- The top of the shoe
- The bottom of the shoe
- Split it up into three sections, the top of the shoe, the middle and the bottom of the shoe

Using simple, light lines to sketch out the basic shape of the shoe and then adding the detail such as laces and logos.



### Extension Task - Grid Drawing

Using a pencil draw the outline of the shoe first. Move from box to box drawing what you see, looking at where the lines start and finish. Then start to add the smaller details.
