Hot Weather Safety in School – sun cream, hats & water bottles

During the summer term we love being outside as much as possible making the most of the good weather, so as it starts to warm up please remember sun cream, hats and water bottles every day for the children:

- Sun cream Please apply sun cream to your children at home before they come to school. If you wish more sun cream to be applied on their child during the day, please send in a labelled bottle in your child's PE kit and let a member of staff know so that we can help guide the children in applying it themselves.
- Hats We require all children to wear a sunhat/cap on sunny days at break times, for PE lessons and on trips. They will be asked to either wear their own hat or they will be given a school hat to wear. Please make sure hats from home are clearly labelled.
- Water bottles The children will be reminded to drink plenty of water especially on hot days. We ask that all children bring a labelled water bottle and they will be given time to refill them in the afternoons.
