I hope all our families enjoyed a lovely half-term break and the children have all returned to school re-energised.

We have flown on our broomsticks into this half term with the whole school Quidditch Day on Wednesday which was brilliant fun! The Sorting Hat assembly started the proceedings by choosing Hogwart's house teams in place of our usual houses for one special day. The classes then took it in turns to compete in inter-house Quidditch tournaments with their special coaches, Meg and Mo.
