School News


 On Tuesday, Class 3 enjoyed an afternoon of practical science with Mrs. Free from Malton Secondary school. This session revised their earlier learning on the topic of electricity. The children tested lots of different metals to see if they could conduct electricity and they even made their own battery out of orange juice! They thoroughly enjoyed their learning and were very appreciative that Mrs. Free came with a wide

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variety of resources for them to use! Their behaviour was superb and Ms. Breese was impressed with how well they collaborated and worked together. They were joined by our new co-opted governor for science, Mrs Jo Breckon, who reported:

'The subject of the session was 'Electricity' which the children had previously studied in the Spring Term. From the very beginning the children were engaged, enthusiastic and actively answering questions and participating in the session. In the first part of the session the children demonstrated great recall of prior knowledge of this topic including a wide range of subject specific vocabulary. The session was very hands-on and throughout this, the children's behaviour was great. They were putting hands up to answer questions, working well in pairs. At times, Mrs Free introduced ideas and vocabulary which was new to them but they listened well and were able to apply this to answering questions later on. They all were able to follow instructions to make a variety of circuits and could use their prior knowledge to make logical predictions. When talking to some of the pairs, they could explain what they were doing, how it worked and use scientific vocabulary to explain why. Throughout the session they were polite to Mrs Free and were a credit to the school.'
