- A letter was emailed out to everyone on Tuesday for our whole school trip to Blakey Ridge for a day of learning on the Moors. Please email the school office with your child's lunch choice by Monday 24th June.
- Class 1 enjoyed a short walk around the village this Monday so the children could compare our local area to a city in China as part of their Geography learning this half term.
- Miss Pearce has visited many of the new Reception children at their pre-school settings this
