Eco Schools: The Results are in!

Here is a breakdown of how families managed to Cut their Carbon during November.

Of the 30 forms that were returned this is what we found:

- 53% made 5 miles of 'active' travel
- 50% went plant-based for a day
- 63% turned down their heating by 1degree for a week
- 70% bought nothing new for a month
- 63% substituted 4 baths for 4 showers of 4 minutes or less
- 70% switched off all non-essential electricals for 1 hour

A huge thank you to everyone who took part. Every effort is important in the wider global effort to reduce carbon.

Ampleforth College Year 7 Scholarship Applications and Open Day

Year 7 2025 11+ Entry Assessment, Scholarship & Experience Days – Friday 24th and Saturday 25th January 2025 - for families applying to Ampleforth College for Year 7 entry in September 2025.

Applications for 11+ Academic, Dance, Drama, Music & Sport scholarships should be submitted by 10th January. Application forms can be found here.

We recognise that the current economic climate and VAT on school fees means parents may be concerned about embarking on this path. Means-tested bursaries can be applied for, and we are happy to have a conversation with any parents or carers who may have questions.

Children will sit scholarship assessments on Friday 24th January, in a choice of disciplines including Dance, Drama, Music and Sport. On Saturday 25th January, Academic scholarships will take place, together with entry assessments and interviews. In the afternoon a carousel of activities will give the children an opportunity to meet future peers and experience a taste of life and the wide co-curricular programme we have here at Ampleforth College. A separate programme will be available for parents.
