Hot Weather Safety in School – sunscreen, hats & water bottles

We are very excited that the sun has been shining so much this week. As it starts to warm up please remember sunscreen, hats and water bottles every day for the children: -

- Sunscreen Please apply sun cream to your children at home before they come to school. If you wish your child to apply more sunscreen at lunch time, please send in a labelled bottle in your child's PE kit and let a member of staff know. If they will need assistance from a member of staff, please complete a sunscreen application form- attached and available on the door.
- Hats We require all children to wear a sunhat/cap on hot sunny days at break times, for PE lessons and on trips. We are not quite there yet with the weather but when it is hot and sunny, they will be asked to either wear their own hat or they will be given a school hat to wear. Please make sure hats from home are clearly labelled.
- Water bottles The children will be reminded to drink plenty of water especially on hot days. We ask that all children bring a labelled water bottle and they will be given time to refill them in the afternoons.



ECO Committee Update from Mrs Breckon

Thanks to everyone playing their part to help us recycle batteries, we are currently on **536!** We hope to make our **new target of 800** by the start of the summer term. A few weeks ago, I was lucky enough to have a tour around Allerton Waste Recovery Park a state-of-the-art facility treating 'black bag' waste from households across the county. This is where your general waste ends up that previously went to landfill. The process is used to generate enough energy to **power over 60,000 homes.** Each year they manage up to **320,000 tonnes of waste** - that's enough to fill more than 2,100 Olympic sized swimming pools!

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While on the tour they explained that **every week they have 3-4 fires** in the system that are caused by **batteries within the black bin waste!!** An amazing statistic that should make us realise how important it is to recycle batteries properly.
