# A Message the Head Teacher

It has been another busy week in school and we have managed to dodge most of the showers: please could all our pupils have a coat/waterproof in school every day so they can still enjoy outdoor playtimes in light rain.

Our Class One teacher, Miss Pearce, is hosting presentations after school tonight for our Reception and Year 1 parents and carers to give guidance on reading in Key Stage 1. We hope to welcome in many of our Class 1 families. Miss Pearce will be explaining how we teach Phonics and what we will continue to do in school to support your child as a developing reader.

Miss Secker and I also held an information evening for our Year 5 and 6 families on Wednesday all about the forthcoming five-day residential trip to Peat Rigg. Thank you to those families who were able to attend and the excitement levels are rising! ## **Flu Vaccination**

Vaccination UK is attending Slingsby school mid-morning of Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October to provide flu vaccinations. For your child to receive their nasal flu vaccination in school, please complete a YES consent form using the link below. The nasal spray is quick, painless and is the most effective option for under 18's. If your child cannot have the nasal spray, the injectable flu vaccine is available, and you will be able to choose that method on the consent form. If you DO NOT wish for your child to have a flu vaccination, please complete a NO consent via the same link <u>Vaccination UK Immunisation</u>.
