Year 1: Narratives including thought and speech bubbles, recipes and expert guides.


EYFS: Blending sounds to read short words; exploring modelled vocabulary; writing short words.

Science (Understanding the World)

Animals including humans: my body
Year 1: How do we change as we get older? What are our senses? How do our senses help us?
EYFS: How have I changed?

Geography (Understanding the world)

Year 1: What is it like here?
EYFS: How is a village different to a town or a city? What do we know about our village? Is our village old or new? How do we know?



Maths (number and numerical patterns)

Year 1: Number: place value within 20; addition and subtraction within 20.
EYFS: Zero- five; mass and capacity; six-eight; doubles; length and height.

Year 1: Safety and the Changing Body
EYFS: Building relationships: special relationships.

DT (Expressive art and design)

Year 1: Moving story books
EYFS: Threading and sewing.



R.E (understanding the world)

Computing (Understanding the World)

Year 1: Skills showcase (mouse and keyboard skills).



P.E (Physical development)

Year 1: Ball skills
EYFS: exploring different ways of moving; movement skills in gross and fine motor.
